

Dr. Kshitij Shankhdhar MD Diabetologist—**Lucknow, India** - Dr. Shankhdhar specializes in diabetic foot care and diabetes education. He obtained his medical degree in India followed by postgraduate training and fellowships in Europe and North America.

In 2011, at Birmingham, UK, he received the 'Highly commended - Innovations in diabetic foot ulcers award' given by Wounds UK. He is the only Indian doctor to hold the fellowship of APWCA (American Professional Wound Care Association) and APWH (Academy of Physicians in Wound Healing, USA). In October 2011, he was granted 'Master of Diabetology' by the University of Zagreb, School of Medicine, Republic of Croatia.

His work in the field of Diabetes care has been selected for oral presentations at esteemed international conferences hosted by associations like The International Diabetes Federation, American Diabetes Association, Canadian Diabetes Association, European Association for the Study of Diabetes, Diabetic Foot Study Group (EASD), Wounds UK, Wound Care Today and the Diabetic Foot Global Conference to name a few.



Dr. Stephen Bartlett DPM, MBA, FACFAS, FAENS – Georgia, USA - Dr. Barrett is a board certified foot and ankle surgeon by the American Board of Foot & Ankle Surgery. He is also board certified by the American Board of Podiatric Orthopedics and Primary Podiatric Medicine. Dr. Barrett is a United States Patent holder for the development of two endoscopic surgical procedures: endoscopic plantar fasciotomy (EPF) and endoscopic decompression of intermetatarsal nerve (EDIN). He has trained more than 6,000 surgeons throughout the world in these techniques. Dr. Barrett is a contributing editor for the Journal of the American Podiatric Medical Association, the editorial board of Podiatry Today, and the editorial board for Practical Pain Management.

Dr. Barrett is considered one of the world's experts in the treatment and diagnosis of heel pain. He is an adjunct associate professor at Midwestern University College of Health Sciences, Podiatric Medicine Program and is the President of the Association of Extremity Nerve Surgeons, a national multidisciplinary organization dedicated to the study and surgery of peripheral nerves. Dr. Barrett received the Jules Tinel, M.D. award in 2010, which is the highest award granted by the nerve society.



Dr. Ali Sadrieh DPM – Beverley Hills, California, USA - Dr. Sadrieh completed his undergraduate degree at UCLA. Following this, completed his podiatric medical training at the University of Osteopathic Medicine and Health Sciences (UOMHS). He then completed a two-year foot and ankle surgical residency at Northridge Hospital Medical Center with an emphasis in elective and reconstructive surgery, trauma, and biomechanics of the foot and ankle, after which he completed a two-year fellowship in wound care of the lower extremities at the Center for Wound Care at Northridge Hospital Medical Center. Dr. Sadrieh's specialty is providing the most advanced and modern cosmetic surgical procedures of the foot. He has pioneered new techniques that allow patients to enjoy shorter recovery periods with minimal pain and an aesthetically pleasing result. Dr. Maggie Fournier DPM – La Crosse, Wisconsin, USA - Dr. Fournier, born and raised in Quebec, is a graduate from the New York College of Podiatric Medicine and currently practices in Lacrosse, Wisconsin. A special interest in sports medicine and surgery lead her to complete a fellowship in Palo Alto, CA under the mentorship of Dr. Amol Saxena. She continues to be involved in sports medicine, and is the immediate Past President of the American Academy of Podiatric Sports Medicine.



Sulejman Mendzildzic MD, MSc, DCh, IIWCC– Brampton, Ontario - Dr. Menzildzic is a Chiropodist with over 20 years of experience researching and treating a multitude of foot conditions. Before moving to Canada in 1995, he graduated from Medical School at the University of Sarajevo. Dr. Menzildzic earned his Master's Degree in Kinesiology (Biomechanics) from the University of Waterloo, where he's worked as a foot care researcher since 1997. His master's thesis studied the comprehensive changes that develop in the human walk when the nervous system begins weakening, as it happens in the ever-growing diabetic population. In 2007, he completed an International Inter-Professional Wound Care Course and became a faculty member of that same course at U of T. He is also involved in publishing several papers in Wound Care, and has been invited to speak at several conferences.



Dr. Michael Ryan PhD, CPed – Vancouver, British Columbia - Dr. Ryan Ph.D is a Certified Pedorthist in Canada with 8 years experience working in outpatient settings within private practice in Canada and through large-scale university health center. After graduating with a PhD in Experimental Medicine from the University of British Columbia, he worked at the University of Wisconsin Madison in the Department of Orthopedics and Rehabilitation.

He is currently the Director of Research and Development at Kintec as well as a Clinical Research Coordinator at Allan McGavin Sports Medicine Centre. In 2011, Dr. Ryan was awarded a Griffith University Post Doctorate Research fellowship.

Dr. Cross has won several National and International awards related to her research such as the Wound Healing Society Young Investigator Award, Trauma Association of Canada Research Award, and Best Clinical Research from the Canadian Society of Plastic Surgeons. She has been recognized for her excellence as a teacher, her collegiality, generosity, mentorship and humanitarianism by receiving the Dr. Hugh Thompson Humanitarian Award and the Leo Mahoney Teaching Award.

Dr. Stephen Perry MSc, PhD – Waterloo, Ontario - Dr. Perry is a Professor of Kinesiology and Physical Education at Laurier University. He received his PhD in Biomechanics/Neuroscience from the Faculty of Medicine, University of Toronto and MSc in Biomechanics from the University of Guelph. Prior to joining Laurier University, he was a Canadian Institute of Health Research postdoctoral fellow at the University of Waterloo.

The primary goal of his research is to gain a better understanding of the control of human movement. Dr. Perry is interested in the control of whole-body mechanics via sensory information from the environment (visual, proprioceptive, mechanoreceptive and vestibular). He intends to translate the outcomes of his research into interventions for reducing falls in the elderly and improving shoes/orthotics for everyday activities and sport.



Dr. Ronald Gary Sibbald BSc, MD FRCPC (Med, Derm), MACP, FAAD, MEd, FAPWCA, D.Sc. (Hons) – Mississauga, Ontario - Dr Sibbald is a dermatologist and internist with a special interest in wound care and education. He is a professor of Medicine and Public Health at the University of Toronto and an international wound care key opinion leader (educator, clinician and clinical researcher).

Dr Sibbald is co-founder of the Canadian Association of Wound Care and was the former Director of the Wound Healing Clinic, Women's College Hospital. He is also past president of the World Union of Wound Healing Societies (2012 – 2016). In 1999 he co-developed the International Interprofessional Wound Care Course and has been the director for 31 courses worldwide. Dr Sibbald is an associate Clinical Editor for the Advances Skin and Wound Care journal and has over 200 publications to his credit.

Professor Sibbald received the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal in 2013 and Honorary Doctor of Science from Excelsior College in 2014.



Dr. Ivan Bristow BSc, MSc, PhD- Hampshire, UK - Dr Ivan Bristow is a Podiatrist in the United Kingdom who has worked in the profession for over 27 years. After leaving the health service, he embarked on an academic career focused on teaching and research. During this time, he completed his Masters Degree at the University of Oxford and his PhD at the University of Southampton. He holds private clinics in Hampshire whilst continuing to work on various dermatology related projects in education and research.

Dr. Bristow has over 100 published papers on foot dermatology and four books. This has led to speaking engagements around the world at many meetings in dermatology, podiatry and wound care.

He wanted to raise awareness for his profession as well as information on how patients can protect your feet from harmful disorders and how they can improve their foot health. 100 million views and over 350,000 subscribers later, "The Toe Bro" is now a 6-episode series on A&E and continues to spread awareness about the profession. Jonathan has also filmed segments for the Dr. Oz show.
